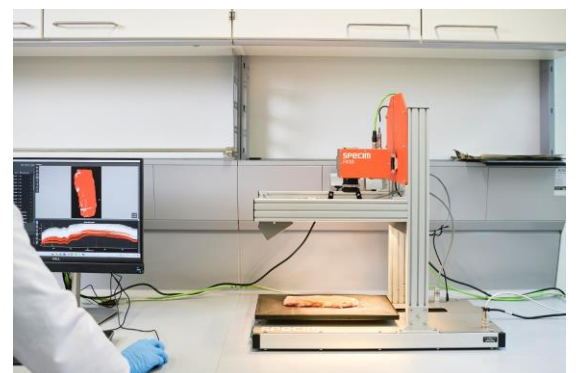


We are looking for team players...
