<b>Exchange Programme</b>	<p>Students from partner universities are eligible for a student exchange within our faculty. In order to come for one semester or a full academic year, students must have been selected by their home university beforehand. It is mandatory for the home university to inform our international relations office of the students they will be sending for the next academic year and of their length of stay in Poitiers.</p> <p>Students must be nominated by email (<a href="mailto:ri.droit@univ-poitiers.fr">ri.droit@univ-poitiers.fr</a>), or via EWP (if operational)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>before June 1st</b> for students arriving for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester and</li> <li>- <b>before November 1st</b> for students arriving for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.</li> </ul> <p>Once their selection is announced to us by their home faculty, students will receive information by email concerning application and enrolment procedures.</p> <p><a href="#">Consult nomination and application procedures</a></p>

<b>Semester Dates</b>	<p><b>Semester 1</b> : First Monday of September until mid-December (Christmas holidays)</p> <p><b>Semester 2</b> : Second week of January until the end of May</p> <p><a href="#">Consult the academic calendar</a></p>
<b>Examination Dates</b>	<p><b>Semester 1</b> : one week mid- November and 2 last weeks of December</p> <p><b>Semester 2</b> : one week in March and entire month of May</p> <p><a href="#">Consult the academic calendar</a></p>
<b>Course Catalogue</b>	<p><b>Exchange students can follow all 1<sup>st</sup> year (L1) to 4<sup>th</sup> year (M1) courses, as well as a few 5<sup>th</sup> year (M2) courses in the field of Political Science.</b> All courses are exclusively in French except for 6 courses in English in the Political Science Master’s programme.</p> <p>The Poitiers Faculty of Law also offers a few <b>courses in Blended Mobility</b> format. When enrolling in one of these blended courses, students follow the course online and must come to Poitiers for a short one-week mobility at some time during the semester.</p> <p><a href="#">Consult the course catalogue</a></p>
