NOMINATIONS & STUDENTS' APPLICATION DEADLINES

Nominations must be **done exclusively by the responsible staff of the partner universities** through **our online platform**. Nominations received **by other means will not be accepted**.

Our partners will receive an email with all the necessary information to make the nominations once the period for nomination approaches.

They must **ensure that the contact details** of the staff responsible for nominations **are up to date in our database**.

1st Period (Academic Year 2025-26): (predictably)

- **Ordinary nomination period: 24th April to 23rd May 2025*** (for 1st, 2nd semester and annual students)
- **Students' application period: deadline 16th June 2025*** (1st semester and annual students)

HEALTH SCIENCES STUDENTS NOMINATIONS:

1st semester, 2nd semester and Annual Health Sciences Students, MUST BE NOMINATED DURING THE ORDINARY PERIOD

2nd Period (Academic Year 2025-26): (predictably)

- **2nd nomination period: 24th September to 24th October 2025*** (only for 2nd semester students)
- **Students' application period: deadline 15th December 2025*** (only for 2nd semester students)

Health Sciences students nominations will not be accepted during the 2nd Nomination Period

*Dates may vary for next academic year 2026-27

ACADEMIC CALENDAR 2025-26

1st Semester (Fall-winter):

Welcome Day: predictably will take place during the **9th – 10th September 2025**

Semester duration: from **11th September 2025** to **22nd January 2026**

Class period: from **11th September** to **19th December 2025**

Exams period: from **8th** to **22nd January 2026**

2nd Semester (Spring-summer):

Welcome Day: predictably will take place during the **21st – 22nd January 2026**

Semester duration: from **23rd January** to **26th May 2026**

Class period: from **23rd January** to **8th May 2026**

Exams period: from **11th** to **26th May 2026**

Extraordinary Exams period:

Only for students who did not pass any subject during ordinary exams periods.

The **extraordinary exams period** will be from **10th June** to **4th July 2026**.

These are Official Dates and CANNOT be changed.

Please bear in mind that **the attendance to the courses is compulsory** so, any delay in the arrival of the student may cause academic problems. **Classes will be 100% in person.**

STUDENT'S APPLICATION, LEARNING AGREEMENT & ACCEPTANCE

Students **MUST NOT** complete the application form if they have not received an e-mail accepting their nomination. (NOMINATION ACCEPTED EMAIL)

Required application documents:

1. **Special needs & adaptations certificate** (if applies) **It must be in Spanish or in English.**
2. **ID/Passport:** Picture or Copy (valid during your mobility period)
3. **Language certificate/s**¹ of their mobility language/s.

Students must have their LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE/S PRIOR TO THEIR NOMINATION.

Otherwise, the application will be stuck, and the student will not be able to go ahead with the process.

BRIEF EXPLANATION of the PROCEDURE that the student MUST follow his/her nomination has been accepted:

1.- Once received the “**Nomination accepted**” email, students **MUST** fill out the **on-line application** and **upload the required documents** according to the corresponding stage.

2.- Once their **first documents** were checked and validated by the URJC, the student will get to the **LEARNING AGREEMENT** stage (URJC Learning Agreement Draft Model), where he/she will have to choose the subjects (the selection **MUST BE DONE** online through our platform).

When drawing up the Learning Agreement, we strongly urge you to check the selected subjects and the number of ECTS credits to ensure that they meet the requirements and needs of the student and the home university regarding possible validations.

Once filled correctly the student must:

- **Download and save** the document. (URJC's Learning Agreement Draft Model).
- Compulsorily complete the corresponding table with the subjects approved at your **Home University (Table B)**.
- **Sign** the document: **Student's and home university's signatures** are mandatory.
- Upload the document to the platform.

In case of having your own model of Learning Agreement, the student must upload his/her model, signed by the student and his/her home university, but **IT IS COMPULSORY TO GENERATE CORRECTLY THE DRAFT OF THE URJC MODEL**. The subjects* (**TABLE A**) and the information in both models **MUST BE THE SAME**. *(Component code, Component title at the Receiving Institution, Semester Number of ECTS credits, etc).

¹ **Language certificate** provided by an official Language Institute (Cambridge, TOEFL, TOEIC, DELE...) or Home University's document that certify that language level. The required is **Spanish B1*** (Spanish B2 is highly recommended), **English B2**. If the student is going to study in both languages, he/she will have to provide both certificates.

***Health Sciences Students** must provide a **B2 Spanish certificate**.

It's not compulsory to certify **mother tongues**; in that case, you can upload a second copy of your passport.

Once uploaded, the **URJC will check the document**, if the Learning Agreement is correct, then URJC will validate and sign it digitally. Then the URJC will issue the **ACCEPTANCE LETTER*** ←
**Only from this moment the student will be considered accepted.*

Please don't send hard copies of the documents neither postal mail nor by e-mail.

The whole procedure must be COMPULSORILY done through URJC's PLATFORM.

Once the semester has started, the student will have the possibility to modify the learning agreement **EXCLUSIVELY** due to **schedule overlap, lack of quota, and academic reasons duly justified by home university**. (Only one Learning Agreement modification is allowed per semester).

Due to external reasons to this service regarding quota availability, URJC cannot guarantee the schedule of the selected subjects. (Students can be assigned to morning or afternoon timetables).

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Before being accepted, students must provide their mobility language certificate, in which they are going to study here at URJC.

If the **language of mobility is English**, the student will need a **B2 certificate** provided by a Language Institute (Cambridge, TOEFL, TOEIC ...) or, failing that, a document from home university that certifies that level of language.

If the **language of mobility is Spanish**, the student will need an official **B1 certificate** (Spanish B2 is highly recommended) or a document from home university that certifies that language level.

Health Sciences Students B2 certificate in Spanish is required.

If the student is going to study both in **English and Spanish**, he/she must provide the required certificates for both languages.

The mother tongue does not need to be certified.

SPANISH LANGUAGE SUPPORT

Spanish courses **MUST NOT be added to the Learning Agreement**, it will not appear on the Transcript of Records since it's competence of the Language Centre, and it has an extra cost. When the students finish the course, they will receive a certificate indicating their attendance, grades and credits.

Semester Spanish Courses (Pending of Confirmation)

Erasmus and Munde students can also attend a Spanish course that will take place during the academic year. Information on duration, registration deadlines, prices, etc. is pending of confirmation.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

EU and EFTA member country citizenship students (Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, and Switzerland) do not need an entry visa, but they do need to obtain the **Union Citizen Registration Certificate**.

Students **from other countries, but from universities in EU and EFTA member countries**, must apply for a **stay authorization for studies for mobility within the European Union**

SEMESTRAL non-community students and from non-community universities must apply for the student visa at the **Spanish Consulates** in the student's home country **NOT** in Spain.

ANNUAL non-community students from non-community universities must APPLY for both the student visa and to the Foreigner Identity Card (*Notice: It is in only available in Spanish Language*):

- **Foreigner ID Card (TIE)** the Spanish acronym for **tarjeta de identidad de extranjero**:

Visa processing can be delayed, so students requiring a visa must **set an appointment at their embassy or consulate** (*in his/her home country*) and **complete their application on our platform as soon as possible** to obtain their acceptance letter.

HEALTH INSURANCE

EU members and EFTA (Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland) even if they have the **European Health Insurance Card**, they **MUST COMPULSORILY** have a **private health insurance** (private health card or private health insurance) to cover the contingencies that may occur during his/her mobility period: Civil Liability, Health issues, (due to illness, accident etc.) and Repatriation.

Non- EU members MUST COMPULSORILY acquire **-before coming to our university- private health insurance** (private health card or private health insurance) to cover the contingencies that may occur during his/her mobility period: Civil Liability, Health issues, (due to illness, accident etc.) and Repatriation.
