

Application procedure for an exchange programme Incoming students

Before starting the registration procedure, each student must be nominated by his/her home university to the Mobility Unit of Paris-Panthéon-Assas University.

1. REGISTRATION

Registration on the Mobility Online application portal is done in 2 steps:

- 1) After your nomination by your home university, click on the dedicated link sent by e-mail and fill in with your birth date.
- 2) Create a login and password.

Your password must be at least 6 characters long, including at least one capital letter and one number.

You will receive an e-mail confirming your registration with your login and the personalised link to reconnect to your Mobility Online space.

2. APPLICATION

Once you have received the e-mail confirming your registration, please log in to your Mobility Online space by following the link and entering your login (username) and password.

- 1) Fill in the form with your personal data. Click on "Forward to update" to enter your address.
- 2) You must then answer the question "Disability" by clicking on "Answer questions". Please note that even if you do not wish to modify the answer, please click on "Forward to update" and validate in order to proceed to the next step.
- 3) Download the required document:
- a copy of a valid identity document (passport or ID card) in PDF format.
- 4) To finalise your application, click on "Confirm" and check the box to indicate that all requested document have been uploaded to Mobility Online

When you have completed all the steps and finished your Mobility Online application, your homepage will look as below :
